I want to register my objection to the choice of "Option A" for the proposed changes to West Hills Rd. and in support of the plan put forth by the West Hills Neighborhood Association for 2 - 10 ft. traffic lanes, 2 - 5 ft. bike lanes, 1 multi-use path, and no shaving of the hill.

This plan will adequately meet the needs for traffic and other uses, with the least disruption to development already in place. So far as safety while crossing the road to the north side, there is only a very short stretch at the top of the hill where the view of on-coming traffic is a serious problem and the likelihood of much crossing taking place in that stretch is minimal.

Please reconsider your decision. Surely the goal of meeting traffic needs with the least disruption is a worthy one.
