Gale,

I am submitting a different request for a grading and excavation permit to fill in the basement of the abandoned Feed Mill located on Campus Way just west of 35th street. The department of Animal Science has asked that I resubmit this alternate proposal for approval. What we would like to do is cave in the existing concrete slab at ground level and let it lay in the bottom of the basement. The basement has two levels, the lower of which is 8' deep by 17.1' by 20' for a total of 101.3 cubic yards. The upper basement level is 34' by 32' by 12' for a total of 484 cubic yards. We would then fill these voids with 1" round pea rock to within 6 inches of the surface. Then we would like to pour a 6" thick, 3500 psi concrete slab, on grade to support farm equipment traffic into the adjacent barn.

I think this proposal coincides with the phone conversation you and I had. If there are any questions please contact me at 737-1290.
