## CONTENT OF DISCUSSION

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. by Chairman Lanny Zoeller.

### 1. Review of Minutes

## 2. **Update Harbor Airlines**

Harbor is planning an April 25<sup>th</sup> start-up date. City Council will meet March 8, 1999 for approval of the lease and operation agreement. Doug Sweetland and John Hope Johnstone will meet to review marketing strategies. Bids for the restroom ADA upgrade, the security equipment, and carpet for the floors are all moving along and should meet the deadline.

## 3. **Update of Jail Site selection**

The Jail Site Committee has narrowed the selection to five sites and will prepare to propose three sites to the County. The two Airport sites have been listed as #8 and #10 on the list and is unlikely to be further considered.. Sites #1 and #2 are both just north of the Airport on each side of the railroad tracks west of 99W where Kieger Island Road would be.

## 4. **Review of Industrial Park Map and Tenants List**

The Industrial Park map has been updated and a tenants list prepared to show the building and proposed building activity in the Park.

## 5. **Information Sharing**

### ■ **Request for use of Airport for operation of Skydiving Club**

Mr. Urban Moore, owner of the Eugene Skydivers Club, has requested to use the Corvallis Municipal Airport for a part-time operations and drop-zone. He has two Cessna 172's and would be interested in a couple of weeks per month from Wednesday to Sunday to operate his Skydiving Club from Corvallis. Open discussion followed. Commissioner Chuck Honey made the motion, and Commissioner Doug Squires seconded.

**Motion: That the Commission advise Manager Taylor to write a letter to Mr. Moore and decline any interest in allowing a skydiving operation on the Corvallis Airport.**

Vote was unanimous in favor.
