### 1 **0010 Scheduling Inspections**

### 2 **0040 Plan Required at Site**

A set of approved plans shall be provided on the jobsite when any inspection is requested. Failure to do so may cause a delay of the requested inspection and may result in a reinspection fee.

### 3 **0250 Structural Tests & Special Inspections**

In addition to the normal building inspections associated with this project, special inspections will be required as outlined in OSSC, and as specified by the architect/engineer of record. The special inspection and testing program shall include, but not be limited to: MASONRY, STEEL FABRICATION, CONCRETE AND REINFORCING STEEL. OSSC Section 1704

### 4 **LDC - Goss Scoreboard**



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It has been confirmed by the Planning Division that the Goss Stadium Scoreboard is located outside of the OSU Historic District, and alterations to the scoreboard are exempt from the requirement for HPP approval.

The scoreboard is also located more than 100 ft. inside the OSU sign exemption area, and is therefore exempt from LDC sign standards.

### 2 **0060 Debris in Public ROW**

Permit holder shall be responsible for complying with City Council Policy #CP91-9.02 which requires all earth or other debris associated with a construction project to be removed from streets and sidewalks each day by 5:00 PM.

### 3 **0250 Permanent Soil Stabilization Required**

All exposed soil must be permanently stabilized against wind and water erosion before the permit can be closed. A final erosion control inspection is required, and can be scheduled by calling 541.766.6745 (see SCHEDULING INSPECTIONS condition for more detail). Permanent soil stabilization includes landscaping, seeding, or covering exposed soil with a minimum 2-inch layer of bark or wood chips. Seeding must be completed by September 1, to allow time for proper germination and growth before the wet weather season. For residential construction, areas of the lot with a final grade of less than 10% slope may substitute a 5-foot wide strip of perimeter stabilization in lieu of complete site stabilization.
