


Economic Impact

Economic impact of Oregon State University spending in Benton County



\$1.312 billion is the combined economic impact of operations spending, capital spending, student spending and visitor spending associated with Oregon State University in Benton County. This represents a 40.5 percent increase since 2011.

Job creation in Benton County as a result of Oregon State University



24,810 jobs have been created from the combined economic impact of Oregon State University. Economic impact and job creation come from three sources:

- » Direct jobs result from Oregon State spending on operations, goods and services, capital construction and payroll.
- » Indirect jobs result from companies purchasing additional supplies or hiring additional employees to support spending by Oregon State.
- » Induced jobs result from the purchasing power of Oregon State employees.
