

PERMIT TO USE PUBLIC PARKING RIGHT-OF-WAY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The applicant may use the Public Right of Way for the uses, dates, times, and parking locations as shown on the permit.

The permit is valid for the described public parking spaces only, and is not for use on sidewalks, yellow curbs, bike and traffic lanes, private parking, or any area where parking is not authorized.

Applicant will display the "No Parking" signs issued by the City at the location of the affected Right of Way no less than 48 hours prior to the permitted use. One sign is given per parking space, or 20 feet of curb length where on-street parking is parallel to the curb. The signs must not be placed in a manner to prevent parking outside of the permitted area.

The applicant is responsible for insuring that the public right-of-way is returned to its condition prior to the permitted activity. The applicant shall not chalk, paint or otherwise mark the surface of bike paths, streets or sidewalk.

The City reserves the right to revoke this permit without notice if the Applicant does not comply with the terms and conditions of the permit or if the City finds it causes an adverse impact to the public.

Applicant will complete and distribute the Right of Way notification form to all affected properties.
